

## **MEETING MINUTES**

### **DFL Senate District 54, Executive Committee Summary**

**February 19, 2009**

- The SD54 Capital Campaign was presented. The goal is to obtain donations through the Political Campaign Refund (PCR) Program. This program allows a yearly donation of \$50 per person or \$100 per couple to a political campaign or party of their choice. The State then refunds the money within about six weeks.
- Affirmative Action meeting is March 4, 2009.
- We need people and committee chair for the Campaigns/Candidate Development committee.
- It was reported that the State Central committee met February 7. The State Chair, Brian Melendez, was reelected, as was the Associate Chair, Donna Cassutt. Secretary, Susan Rego; Treasurer, Lori Sellner, Affirmative Action Office, Jamie Edwards. Five gubernatorial candidates spoke at the meeting: Susan Gaertner, John Marty, Matt Entenza, Doug Peterson and Chris Coleman.
- An idea was presented for individuals to pool their stimulus money (est. \$400 each) and see what they could do to make a difference. There will be a meeting 2/19/09 with Community Action Project to discuss this possibility, using a pool of funds as described above.
